Appointed as Ambassador plenipotentiary and extraordinary of The Republic of Yemen to Egypt in 31, October 2023 until current.

Appointed as Advisor to the President of the Republic Of Yemen from April 3, 2016 until October 30, 2023.

Appointed as Vice-President of the Republic of Yemen on 13 April 2015 until 3 April 2016 in addition to his duties as Prime Minister.

Formed The Technocrat Government on November 7, 2014 when the attempt of forming a Government of political unity failed.

Assigned to form a government of national unity by political consensus October 13, 2014 following the fall of Sanaa by the Houthis.

Appointed on 12 June 2014 as a Permanent Representative of Yemen to the United Nations.

Appointed on 8 March 2014 as a Minister of Oil and Minerals for the second time for an interim term.

Appointed as Ambassador of Yemen to Canada in December 2008, and presented the credentials to Her Excellency Michaëlle Jean, Governor-General. Begun duties as Ambassador and Extraordinary Commissioner for Yemen to Canada on 21 January 2009. During this period, was elected President of the Diplomats' Association from 2009 to 2010.

From February 2006 to May 2008, led the Ministry of Oil and Minerals of Yemen, managing this important ministry and its multiple bodies. At the same time served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yemen LNG at an estimated cost of five billion US dollars, served on the Board of Directors of the General Investment Authority and the Supreme Council for Economic and Petroleum Affairs, and the Export Committee.

Worked as the Director of the Arab Cement Company Project from September 2005 to May 2008 (Hadramawt Cement Factory Project -US\$250,000,00).

In 1992 obtained a master's degree in Commerce from Pune University, specializing in Administration, banking and finance. Also obtained the bachelor degree in Commerce specializing in accounting and advanced auditing from the same university. In the same year, joined Canadian Nexen Petroleum Company and served in several senior posts as Director of Planning, Joint Ventures, Human Resources and other departments.
